Volunteer Ethics Agreement

1. I believe in the sanctity of human life as taught in the Bible. Therefore, I reject abortion as an acceptable option for a teenager or woman facing a crisis pregnancy. I will not participate in any action which results in the end of an innocent human life.
2. I will uphold the trust placed in me by the staff, Board of Directors, supporters and clients. I commit to keep in complete confidence all information pertaining to clients, donors, supporters, and finances. I understand that violating confidentiality in any area is grounds for immediate termination of my position. I will continue to keep all information confidential even if I no longer volunteer for the Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC).
3. I have read, understand and agree with the PRC Statement of Faith and Commitment of Care and will uphold them as well as all policies and procedures established by PRC.
4. I understand that PRC is a Christian organization consisting of staff and volunteers from multiple denominations. I will not discuss doctrinal beliefs that may be divisive. Even though we may come from varying doctrinal backgrounds, we are one in Christ. I agree to work to promote help, hope and the Gospel to our clients, based upon our agreement with PRC Statement of Faith. PRC welcomes help from those who love the Gospel of Jesus Christ, who are in agreement with our historic Christian beliefs, and have a personal relationship with God.
5. As a PRC staff member or volunteer I will not encourage or refer artificial birth control to clients. I understand that PRC is not a medical clinic; therefore, those working for PRC (including volunteer licensed-nurses) may not refer or encourage the use of birth control. Also, many of the people I serve with believe artificial birth control to be morally objectionable. I can, however, offer **married** couples information about fertility awareness and natural family planning.
6. I will be dependable. Good intentions that lead to missed appointments or unfinished tasks leave PRC vulnerable to losing credibility and trust from those we seek to serve. I will be on time, remain for my shift and fulfill a one-year commitment (unless a shorter period is approved) by PRC.
7. I will maintain a servant's heart. Some of the jobs to be done at the PRC are exciting and others menial. Staff and volunteers work together as a team and help where we are needed (non client contact volunteers will not be asked to do anything they have not been taught through training). I will commit to the completion of the PRC training and to ongoing training.
8. I will continue to pursue growth in Jesus Christ. I will attend church regularly and continue Christian growth through personal and small group study.
